We at Envirokids provide environmental education to young people in Tanzania. Our purpose is to empower a new generation of green leaders with partnerships from Primary Schools to Universities. Together we form a platform for young people to act and engage extensively in the mitigation of climate change by providing environmental education, introducing school clubs and engage children by initiating various activities. One of our key projects are tree nurseries for hands-on responsibility, that are maintained by the kids themselves in school clubs.

We believe, that these kids will be future ambassadors who bring awareness to communities, especially the younger generation that will help bridge the poverty gap and mitigate climate change in Tanzania and the world.

A total of 9,500 seedlings from our nursery were successfully transplanted and planted on two different farms by the Catholic brothers, who also run St. Mary's Boys' School, where one of our nurseries is based.




# ZERO WASTE CAMPAIGN WITH VIJANA NA MAZINGIRA






# NGANZA SCHOOL CLUB GRADUATION

# BOSCH CENTS FOR HELP WASTE MANAGEMENT

Hongera sana! In May 2024 Enviro Kids e.V. won the Bosch Cents for Help fund of incredible 5000 Euro! The project proposal is a cooperation with Enviro Kids Organisation to implement a waste bin and recycling infrastructure in Mwanza University district. High plastic pollution in this district especially, causes microplastic pollution in the fields and lake Victoria, despite being the main source of their lively hood.



Cut-off from the inner city waste system, we aimed to fill the gap, cooperating with the local district and street wards to include the local recycling facility for circularity.

# BOSCH CENTS FOR HELP WASTE MANAGEMENT

Il plastic waste bins have been installed throughout the district. The initial design idea of a separation system routing down to germanys role model was adopted by our organisation onsite members with a focus on recyclable plastic waste. A traditional waste separation is not implementable as per Germany since no collection system is given. Together with the local wards the placement of the waste bins was arranged, a responsible waste collector was appointed and community trainings are being held. So far, the new system is a great success while also creating a new income source for the waste collector. Over 1 metric ton of plastic haven been already collected and will be recycled as we write this report in March 2024





# HSA X SAUT UNIVERSITY JOINT LECTURE SUPPORT

#### **Enviro Kids goes Academia!**

In October 2024, Enviro Kids e.V., in partnership with the Enviro Kids Organization, secured a collaboration with Hochschule Anhalt (HSA) and SAUT University in Mwanza, Tanzania. Under the supervision of professors from both universities—particularly within Professor Michelis' Social Citizenship course at HSA—we integrated environmental education into the lecture concept.

As a guiding stakeholder, we facilitated collaboration between German and Tanzanian students, who jointly developed initiatives in the areas of mindset shifts, circularity, and climate impact. Through this process, they worked together to create practical solutions. Beyond intercultural exchange, they also learned to listen to different perspectives on climate change and connect their experiences to adaptable solutions.

# HSA X SAUT UNIVERSITY JOINT LECTURE SUPPORT

The best project will be selected based on their project reports, which are due in March 2025. The jury will be composed of all Enviro Kids e.V. and organization members. A budget of 1,000 euros will be awarded to the best initiative, which will be executed under the name of the Enviro Kids organization onsite in Mwanza.

From what we have seen so far, promising solutions have been found, including interactive education paths, waste exchange bank systems, and self-sustaining school gardens.

### RUAHA INDEPENDENCE DAY SUPPORT

The 9th December marks a special day in Tanznaia: The Independence Day!

Celebrating the founding of the nation as it is known known today, back in 1961. Nowadays focus is on garding a sustainable future.

The RUCU Students Environmental Club under steering of our dear general secretary professor Emanuel Rubeni developed several activities such as debates for the Independence Day Celebrations held at RUCU University. Those Activities were sponsored by Enviro Kids being the

official supporter of the

environmental club. Including 250


Trees that were planted with additional support of the national tree afforestation program.





This year brought both challenges and progress to our environmental efforts. One of the biggest setbacks occurred at our project with AIESEC at SAUT University, where more than 600 trees were lost.

The cause? A lack of consistent monitoring—both on our part and from partnering institutions—left the site unprotected. Farmers likely set fire to the fields, a common local practice to encourage fresh grass growth after the dry season. With no fences or signs in place, the openly accessable area was highly vulnerable.





Learning from this, we have started replanting and have strengthened our commitment with the partnering institutions to prevent similar incidents in

the future. While fences are currently not affordable, we are working closely with SAUT University's security teams to ensure better oversight, as the land officially belongs to the university.

In addition to this, extreme dryness delayed the planting of 400 more trees, as conditions were simply not suitable. However, we remain prepared to act as soon as the weather allows. Despite

these challenges, our determination remains strong. We continue to push for meaningful partnerships, even as we face limited institutional support.



# ORGANISATIONAL REVIEW WORK STRUCTURES

2024 was a year of professionalism at Enviro Kids Organisation. Through our cooperation with Enviro Kids e.V., we received support for capacity development and formed a working committees structure. The goal is to ensure successful project execution and, with a speacial focus on financial guidelines, to attract and transparently manage donor funds. The structures formed are used on both NGO sides to create smooth project development and are mirrored in our internal communication channels.

Measurably, our proficiency and efficiency have improved.



# ORGANISATIONAL REVIEW OPERATIONS

Also, Enviro Kids e.V. successfully applied for the Google Nonprofit Workspace, establishing a documentation structure for our cooperative projects.

With efficient administration, strong member commitment and fun at work we have shown great projects success, avoiding unnecessary administration overhead and ensured once again:


# ORGANISATIONAL REVIEW MEMBER DEVELOPMENT


As this report reflects the strong cooperation between Enviro Kids Organisation and Enviro Kids e.V., both member developments will be described shortly.

Enviro Kids Organisation counts 11 Tanzanian members in 2024 and 9 members from other countries. A particularity of Enviro Kids e.V. is, that those 9 members are the founding members of the NGO. With the idea to broaden the education network to Europe and connecting perspectives and foster collaboration, Enviro Kids e.V. was funded out of the Tanzanian NGO initially. However, that cooperation is not exclusive and Enviro Kids e.V. is open for any international cooperation further than Enviro Kids Organisation.

From the total 20 members regarding Enviro Kids Organisation including Enviro Kids e.V., 12 are male and 8 female, still lacking an equal share of gender. The Director Boards is consisted of 4 male and one female for Organsiaiton, and 2 female and 1 male of Enviro Kids e.V.


#### Share of members by gender - Enviro Kids Organisation and Enviro Kids e.V combined





With 16 of 20 members under the age of 35, both Enviro Kids Organisation and Enviro Kids e.V. are youth-led organizations. This is especially important to us, as both organizations aim to represent youth voices in the joint fight against climate change.





# INVESTMENT & FINANCE: MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS

With the founding of the German association Enviro Kids in early 2024, we were able to stabilize our revenue and strengthen cooperation with European donors and partners. This year, we funded our activities not just through membership fees but also by increasing donations. The financial stability of the German association relies on membership contributions, and we introduced a sponsorship membership fee.


Like last year we forgo a fixed fee, allowing members to contribute based on their income. In the European association, the minimum contribution is 10€ per month, and in Tanzania, it is 10,000 TSh (around 4 USD), plus a one-time registration fee of 10,000 TSh.

We received several generous donations this year, including 5,000 USD from "Bosh Cents for Help," enabling us to launch a project in Mwanza to reduce plastic waste.

Thanks to our donors, we aim to secure further financial stability in 2025 through additional grants and external funding. This will allow us to cover our administrative costs and school project expenses with membership contributions, while larger projects will be funded through donations.


## **EXPENDITURES**

Membership contributions are used for overarching fix costs maintaining our projects. Such as purchasing materials, transportation costs for the tree planting projects and tree nurseries. A smaller amount is required to buy educational materials such as experimental equipment or sweets for the children, as well as food allowances for our project manager and the members working on-site in the projects. The administrative costs, including account maintenance fees, are also covered by the membership contributions.

In 2023, we have rented a volunteer house in the city of Mwanza to host up to 20 volunteers. Consequently in 2024, expenses were allocated to the renovation and house investments like expanding the office and kitchen. Ongoing costs for electricity and water, as well as food allowances for our project and facility manager Amani, were also covered. Following a member decision in December 2023, he receives a compensation of 125 USD per month starting in 2024.


